


I CYCLE OF STUDIES (BACHELOR)



INTRODUCTION

This Study Plan and Program (SPP) at the Military Academy "General Mihailo Apostolski" - Skopje is intended for the primary level of education of candidates for officers of the Army of the Republic of Macedonia. The SPP aims to present the structure of education presented through the content of the course subjects and the number of hours.

The training of candidates for officers at the Military Academy is an integral part of the defense education and training system. Within this system, the Military Academy provides continuous professional education, starting from the initial entry level, acquiring the initial officers' ranks, qualifications for promotion to a higher rank and transition from one level to another (tactical, operational and strategic). This kind of education enables future officers to acquire and demonstrate self-confidence, integrity, critical judgment and responsibility, which are necessary features necessary for acting in complex, unpredictable and dynamic situations, in which the ability to build an effective team implies the possession of wide organizational and technological knowledge.

Within the framework of education, the Military Academy covers various forms of institutionally and continuously shaping the knowledge, skills and abilities of future officers. This system consists of education and training as its subsystems, used to build the qualities and behavior of future officers. These two systems are complementary and mutually intertwining within each of the levels of further professional development.

Education enables the development of intellectual capacity and acquiring general and specialized specialist knowledge. It initiates the process of learning and creating a creative way of thinking in solving the tasks set. Having the right level of education is a fundamental career demand and must be exercised effectively in order to support the new career structure and reflect the key moments of career advancement. The results of education can be measured directly through formal examinations, and are conducted through individual testing or by continuous examination of the conduct of candidates for the officers during the course of teaching in a given period of time.

Training provides the acquisition of skills and applied knowledge that are required for each specific job or any form of specialization. In essence, it is about adopting formations and procedures, through a process of progressive repetition of the envisaged tasks. As a result of the training, improvement of skills and ability for quality performance of specific tasks should arise.

1. EDUCATION AND TRAINING OF CANDIDATES FOR OFFICERS

1.1. Basic characteristics of the officer's poses that need to be developed among the candidates for officers during schooling

Primary education for acquiring the first officer's rank, candidates for officers should acquire knowledge that will enable them to possess and demonstrate the most important features of each officer, and they are the following:

- competence;
- Initiative and proper reasoning:
- creativity;
- flexibility;
- trust;
- loyalty.

In addition to the above, the candidate for an officer must be:

- qualified for team work;
- efficient manager;
- capable of communicating effectively

Competence: Each officer must be competent in all aspects of his functional position and to know his specific duties and responsibilities better than any other. He must also be familiar with the duties of the other members of the unit, in order to achieve vertical and horizontal (lateral) coordination, in order to successfully and effectively carry out the mission set. From the officer appointed to the first commuting duties, the superior always expects a proper and efficient execution of the given missions: to know to take on a given task, to plan, organize and perform successfully any set task in an optimal and efficient manner.

Initiative and Proper Reasoning: The officer appointed to the basic command duties should have an initiative to anticipate needs. He also needs to make good judgments in order to quickly understand the situation, to determine what is important and to do what is necessary. He should not wait for the supervisor to give him specific guidance on when and where to act. He must foresee what is necessary for the execution of the mission, as well as the questions that the commander will set in order to make a decision. He must know the intent of the superiors - two levels higher and always act within that purpose. He should not hesitate to take advantage of the opportunities offered to carry out the mission in the absence of his superiors, but he must always ask himself, "If the superiors were here, would he tell me this to do?" Then, he must inform the superiors for their actions, in the first indicated opportunity.

Creativity: The superiors always seek new and innovative solutions to the problems. Each officer must be creative in seeking solutions to difficult and specific situations. Creative thinking and critical reasoning are skills that assist the officer in developing and appropriate analysis of the variants of action. If he can not recommend a variant of action in one direction or area, then he must find an alternative. He must be a team player and use the creativity of all members of the unit. The officer must always give his superior recommended action variant. He must look for ways to support the subordinate units and should not tell the "no" to the commander of the subordinate unit, unless he clears it with his commander.

Flexibility: The officer must be mentally mature and aware of changes in needs and priorities and not allow them to succumb to them or frustrate them. The commanding commander will often change the decisions or directions after receiving additional information or new requests from his commander. Often he does not tell the subordinate officer why he suddenly changed his decision. The officer must remain flexible and adapt to the needs and desires of the superiors. He must also remain flexible when diverted in different directions from different superiors. It must guide the setting of priorities when there are more tasks to be done than there is time available. In addition, he must know at the same time to manipulate with more obligations. It is necessary for the officer to meet the expectations in time, because the superiors depend on his information needed for the process of solving the problem. He must meet expectations or inform his superiors in advance of the time that will be needed and request adjustment of time or priority.

Trust: The officer must have mental discipline and confidence in order to be aware of the fact that the entire work of the unit is in the service of the commander-commander, although the commander may reject the final recommendation. The officer must not give up his efforts because he thinks that the commander-commander will not agree with the recommendation. The officer must understand that often for a five-minute response to the commander, it may take ten hours of work on the unit.

Loyalty: The loyalty of the officer to his commander-in-command is really special. In addition, the officer is loyal to individual soldiers. The officer must be loyal to the commander-commander. Respecting loyalty will help an officer tell the commander-in-command information as it is, and not what he wants to be. The officer must have the moral courage to communicate to the commander "good" and "bad" news. The old saying: "Bad" news never improves over time, is suitable for every officer.

Teamwork skills: Each officer must be capable of teamwork. He can not independently perform the requested activities and things, he must be advised, consulted and cooperated with others. He must be ready to present the decisions of others as if he were his own. Also, a wise officer should maintain a pleasant mood, as this will help achieve the results that he otherwise could not achieve.

Effective Manager: Each officer should be able to manage time and resources effectively. Time will always be of particular importance. He should think not only of his time, but also of the time needed for other members of the unit, of the subordinate units, or of everyone else who participates in the execution of the assigned mission (mission). The officer must be aware that any project can not be naturally. It should be capable of setting acceptable expectations that will enable the execution of a non-priority project.

Each officer should be a good manager of the resources (people, environment and money) that the country entrusts to him. It should be worthwhile to advocate for the efficient management of these resources and for the preservation of the environment. This means avoiding wasted spending, destroying and duplication of efforts.

Competence for effective communication: Each officer must be capable of communicating effectively. Effective communication is necessary for him. He should clearly express the intentions and decisions of the presumed oral, written and visual (with schemes and graphs). Every officer should be skilful in the oral briefing of individuals and groups. He needs to know and understand the right techniques for briefing and be able to transmit complex information that is easily understood.

Every officer should know how to express himself in writing. He should write in writing the intent of the superiors and instructions through tactical orders, tactical plans, studies, summaries and reports from the subordinate elders.

Every officer needs to know productively to use the latest computer technology. This also involves the creation of visual briefing products such as charts, graphs and slides, or other multimedia briefing products that will help transfer the intention and wishes of the commander. He also needs to successfully use computer technology for data processing, e-mail and other available resources, for more efficient time use and for solving problems.

Each officer often prepares briefings or written documents for the commander-in-command or for another superior officer. The officer should prepare the document exactly as he needs to sign it or brief it.

Primary education should include the training of officers for officers on the general characteristics of officers.

- military values in the ARM, such as duty, honor, ability, courage, fidelity and integrity;
- for the code of conduct of the members of the ARM, according to the given provisions;
- professionalism;
- military spirit/ethics;
- Leadership.

The most important features and qualities to be possessed by each operating leader:

- the leader must be a good instructor, educator and teacher;
- to have confidence in the subordinates;
- occasionally personally solve problems;

- to achieve good communication along a vertical and horizontal line;
- to manage and use time well;
- to believe in his intuition;
- have the ability to solve problems with indiscipline and inadequate personnel;
- to take care of their subordinates;
- to have vision, creative unrest and innovation;
- subordinate personal ambitions and ego to the goals of the organization it manages;
- know how to manage meetings and work arrangements;
- understand the process of adopting, executing and controlling decisions;
- be transparent and accessible;
- be resolute, but also careful;
- be self-critical;
- be confidential;
- be open to new ideas, suggestions and the acceptance of force of arguments;
- to create and maintain a high degree of dignity;
- To be honest and support honesty.

The basic principles of leadership are:

- Knowledge of self and self-advancement;
- skill and knowledge;
- personal responsibility and determination of the responsibility of others;
- knowledge of the subordinates and care for them;
- division of tasks and engagement of the subordinates according to their abilities and affinities;
- ability for teamwork.

PRIMARY LEVEL OF EDUCATION FOR CANDIDATES FOR OFFICERS FOR LOGISTICS SPECIALITIES AND SERVICES
IN THE ARMY OF THE REPUBLIC MACEDONIA
IN MILITARY ACADEMY "GENERAL MIHAILO APOSTOLSKI"

2. OBJECTIVES AND TASKS OF SCHOOLING

2.1. Objective of schooling

The general goal to be achieved through the system of schooling of officers is to create a well-educated officer corps, which will be fully competent in technical, tactical and leadership terms, as well as possess the skills, knowledge and capabilities needed to deal with all the challenges that they imposes the modern way of fighting.

The special goal of education and training in the Military Academy is the formation of leaders and comprehensive development of the personality of future officers, psychophysical and morally prepared and professionally qualified to perform the formative duties in the Army of the Republic of Macedonia (ARM) in peace and in war.

The training of candidates for ARM officers should enable:

- acquisition of general and specialized specialist knowledge as a basis for training for the initial command duties, for further education and training for higher command and other managerial duties, as well as for self-education and development of the social, cultural, moral and other qualities of the personality of the officers the ARM;
- acquiring the necessary practical knowledge, skills and habits and training for the execution of the initial command and other formation duties in the units of the ARM.

2.2. Tasks of schooling

2.2.1. General

The general tasks of schooling are:

- 1. The development of the moral, aesthetic and psycho-physical characteristics of the person, necessary for carrying out a professional military service, as well as high awareness and patriotism towards all values and traditions in the Republic of Macedonia.
- 2. Adoption of theoretical and practical knowledge from the general and military-specialty educational and educational areas, with the focus of the military science in the domain of the gender for successful management and commanding of the units.
- 3. Development of leadership capabilities and preparation of candidates for officers for human work, management and command of the appropriate gender in the more complex, variable and unpredictable conditions of peaceful and military practice.
- 4. Adoption of theoretical and applied technical and military technical knowledge and training for the efficient use of the current information, combat-technical systems, weapons, material assets and equipment in conditions of modern warfare.
- 5. Adoption of modern knowledge and skills necessary for military training and psycho-physical training of individuals and units from the domain of gender-logistical specialties, the service for armed struggle in conditions of a defensive war.
- 6. Preparation of the candidates for managing and commanding the basic tactical units of gender in all forms of armed struggle and types of combat actions, in accordance with the requirements of the concept of defense and protection of the state.
- 7. To familiarize the candidates with the organization, formation and principles for the use of the tactical units of some foreign armies, training for the organization of the fiery reconnaissance of the enemy and the implementation of the basic measures for security and protection in the ARM units.
- 8. Acquiring a systematic, planned and conscientious approach to work and obligations and training candidates for continuous professional self-education officers.
- 9. Training of candidates for officers for written and oral expression and communication in their duty.

2.2.2. The specific objectives of schooling

The specific objectives of schooling are:

- 1. Introduction and training for practical application of the basic tactical and combat procedures of an individual, unit and platoon, in all types and conditions for conducting combat actions.
- 2. Introduction to morality (code of conduct of officers, ethics, etc.) in the ARM as a factor on which the quality of the realization of the combat tasks depends.
- 3. Introduction and training for the proper performance of the tasks and obligations arising from the Law on Service and the Rule of Service in the Army of the Republic of Macedonia.
- 4. Introduction to the basic contents of the basics of military management and management of training and military law and consistent application in practice.
- 5. Candidates for officers to learn the basic principles of the organization for the appropriate logistical specialty or service and the provision of the ARM in peace and in war conditions.
- 6. Training for the proper implementation of the basic procedures of the individual training, grade and platoon.
- 7. Adoption of specialized specialist knowledge for the handling and use of equipment and weapons of the appropriate branches in conditions of contemporary combat.
- 8. Getting acquainted with the general tactics and tactics of logistics specialties, according to the adopted and accepted NATO standards.

3. STRUCTURE, ORGANIZATION AND CALCULATION OF SCHOOL DURATION

3.1. Structure and organization of the primary level of education for officers of logistics specialties and services




Figure 1. Primary level for officers of logistics specialties (for getting an initial officer rank)

The training of candidates for officers of logistics specialties and services is realized in two phases, ie three modules (Figure 1), as follows:

- the first and second modules are realized together, in the first phase,
- third module military training for appropriate logistics specialty and service.

Holder of a complete education is the Military Academy, and cooperate with the Command for Training and doctrine (CTD). The first module (basic military training) is realized by Command for Training and doctrine (CTD) with its facilities and it cooperates in implementing the third module (military specialties schooling) by performing a practical applied forms of military training.

In the first and second module of the first phase of the training and education the same contents are conducted with the candidates for all logistics specialties and services.

In the third module of the second phase is covered professional-specialist training for relevant logistical and specialty service.

At the primary level, a leadership course for commanders of platoons is also realized, where the candidates acquire the knowledge and the ability to command a platoon. This course is realized within the III phase. The carrier of the course is the Military Academy.

3.1.1. Basic military training, FIRST PHASE, 1. MODULE

3.1.1.1. Goal of the basic military training

General goal

Candidates for officers should be able to effectively handle personal weapons and equipment, to correctly apply tactics, techniques and procedures in performing tasks in all combat conditions. Basic military training should serve as a good basis for further education of candidates for officers to be trained to perform the initial duty officer commanding a platoon.

Special goals

- 1. Candidates for officers to get acquainted with the basic characteristics and values of the human defense factor.
- 2. To become acquainted with the tasks and obligations arising from the Rule of Service in the Army of the Republic of Macedonia.
- 3. To be able to properly apply the basic procedures of the Structural Training.
- 4. To be trained in the handling of personal weapons and equipment.
- 5. Apply basic tactics, techniques and combat procedures to an individual in all combat conditions.
- **6.** Psychophysical to be prepared to respond to all the challenges and difficulties that can be encountered the candidates for officers in the performance of tasks.

3.1.1.2. Organizing the training

The training should be planned, organized and implemented according to the Rule of Service in the Army of the Republic of Macedonia.

The training and other tasks should be realized in a period of 35 working days

3.1.2. General education, FIRST PHASE, 2. MODULE

3.1.2.1. Purpose of general education

In this module of education, with the study of general subjects, candidates for officers for the army branches should acquire:

- basic knowledge of the national security system at the center of knowledge of the defense subsystem, that
 is, the military defense subsystem of the Republic of Macedonia.
- fundamental theoretical and practical knowledge of the general tactics and tactics of the branches and services, and to train for creative and non-academic approach in the study and practical application of the principles of organization and the conduct of the struggle and the battle and the principles of using tactical units.
- basics of command and control;
- Basic knowledge in the field of military history and the evolution of wars.
- basic military-geographic features of the Macedonian space, to get acquainted with the elements of the topographic map in detail, as well as to acquire theoretical and practical knowledge and skills for orientation and land measurements;
- basic English language skills listening, speaking, reading and writing, as well as common technology and terminology specific for individual directions and levels;
- Proper development of motor skills, adoption of the necessary knowledge, skills and habits to form in a
 versatile person capable of carrying out all military tasks in combat and in peace, and methodically to be
 able to organize and perform all forms of physical education in the ARM.

3.1.2.2. Organizing classes

The teaching should be planned, organized and realized according to the Statute of the Military Academy.

The teaching and other tasks should be completed for 12 weeks (8 weeks for teaching + 2 weeks for SFT + 2 weeks for passing exams) or 60 working days.

The teaching is to be realized in five working days a week with eight hours a day (6 am and 2 pm) or 40 hours a week (30 hours in the morning and 10 hours in the afternoon).

3.1.3. Professional -specialist education, SECOND PHASE, 3. MODULE

3.1.3.1. Object of expert and the specialist education

In this phase of education, by studying professional-specialized subjects, the candidates for officers should acquire military specialist knowledge, skills and habits for the role of the officer of the appropriate logistics specialty-service of the ARM, as well as to be able to perform the duty of the commander of a platoon in the appropriate logistical specialty-service of the ARM in peace and war. It also need:

- to acquire knowledge, skills and habits and to be able to properly and safely use and maintain the armaments and military equipment of the appropriate branch of the ARM;
- to acquire knowledge about the ARM generation for which they are educated and trained, and in particular:
 the purpose, role, organization, formation, combat opportunities and basic use, as well as for the preparation of conditions for combat action of a department, platoon;
- to acquire basic knowledge, skills and habits and to be able to command a section and platoon of the
 appropriate branch in the ARM in carrying out the dedicated tasks in combat, independently and in
 cooperation with the units of other branches, with respect to the international military standards and norms;
- to acquire basic knowledge and to be able to plan, organize, conduct and realize the training with a soldier,
 NCO, section and platoon of the appropriate logistics specialty-service in the ARM;
- be psychologically prepared for work as an officer in the Army of the Republic of Macedonia.

Candidates for officers are trained to perform the work and duties of the officer, acting commander of a platoon in the following specialties and logistics services:

- Maintenance;
- Supply;
- Movement and transport;
- Medical support;
- Infrastructure:
- Music service:
- Legal service;
- Financial service:
- Information service;
- Meteorological service;
- General military specialty.

3.1.3.2. Organizing classes

The teaching should be planned, organized and realized according to the Statute of the Military Academy.

Teaching and other tasks should be realized for 18 weeks (14 weeks for teaching + 2 weeks for preparation and taking exams) or 90 working days.

The lesson is to be realized in five working days a week with eight hours a day (6 am and 2 pm) or 40 hours a week (30 hours in the morning and 10 in the afternoon).
